

3. SCHOOL UNIFORM

Purpose

- To ensure that students develop a spirit of belonging to the school.
- To create equitable presentation of students.
- To assist in maintaining student safety.

Guidelines

- Information on the uniform for school and PE, as well as information on personal grooming is detailed in the school dress code section of the handbook, diary and on the school website.
- Enrolment of their children assumes acceptance and support, by parents, of these guidelines and appropriate sanctions for non-compliance.
- School uniform requirements will be reviewed as necessary.
- All items of personal clothing and footwear should be named.
- All members of staff are responsible for monitoring the correct wearing of school and PE uniform.
- In matters relating to uniform, the following considerations will be taken into account:
 - cost
 - pride in the school and individual self-esteem
 - practicality
 - the image of the school in the community
 - students' and parents' views via the Uniform Committee.
- Uniforms for sporting teams or codes must be approved by the Teacher i/c Sport before commissioning.
- A Uniform Committee considers, researches and makes recommendation to the Board on any changes to the uniform. It meets on an ad hoc basis.
