- **Year 9 Agriculture & Horticulture** requires 1 x 1B8 exercise book. Write-on workbooks are issued in class.
- **Year 9 Art** taster Term 1 equipment supplied by the Art Department.
- **Year 9 Option Art** starting Term 2 Junior Art Pack (pre-packaged) issued in class. Charged to account in Term 2.
- **Design and Visual Communication** – For Term 1, students need to have, 1 x HB wooden pencil and 1 x eraser.
- All **Digital Technologies** taster students require 1 x clearfile (20 pages minimum).
- **ESOL** students require 1 x 1B8 exercise book.
- **Year 9 Food and Nutrition** – Workbooks to be issued in class.
- **French** Language students will require 1 x 1B8 exercise book.
- **Spanish** Language students will require 2 x 1B8 exercise books.
- **Japanese** students will require a 1B8 + 1H5 exercise book from Term 2.
- **Maori** language students will require 1 x 2B5 exercise book.  
Also from Term 2, 1 x *Maori to Go* write on workbook 1
- **Year 9 Music** – no stationery required
- **Year 9 Fashion and Design** – stationery to be advised start of Term 2.
- Devices are required for Year 9 students. See the school website for details.
- **Student Support Centre** 1 x 20 Pocket red display book  
1 x 20 Pocket blue display book  
4 x 2B8 exercise books

**A number of Option Subjects have additional requirements at the end of Term 1. These requirements will be indicated at that time.**
