

# 5. ENGLISH FOR SPEAKERS OF OTHER LANGUAGES

## **Purpose**

The school has a commitment to providing quality education in all curriculum areas to students from all non-English speaking backgrounds.

#### **Procedures**

The school and the Board of Trustees recognise:

- The expectations of the New Zealand Curriculum with respect to Cultural Diversity, equity and our obligations as International Citizens.
- The special needs of ESOL students in the school community.
- The need to maintain sensitivity and cultural awareness of the students' ethnic background.
- The need to plan, implement, monitor and evaluate appropriate ESOL programmes to ensure achievement in all learning areas for ESOL students.

#### Guidelines

- The school and Board of Trustees will be mindful of the commitment to provide quality ESOL programmes for their ESOL students.
- The school and school community will have a commitment to professional development of staff involved in the delivery of ESOL programmes.
- The school will regularly provide opportunities for integration.
- The school will monitor student visas and all other documentation pertaining to migrant students to ensure they are appropriate.
- If the parent of a student is in New Zealand on a working visa, that parent must ensure their permit is kept current for the duration of their child's education at James Hargest College.
- All students will be screened at the time of enrolment to ascertain the level of English Language support they require and whether they qualify for migrant or refugee funding.

### Conclusion

The school, Board of Trustees and school community will aim to deliver quality ESOL programmes to students, where appropriate, to further the multi-cultural richness of the school, and enhance ESOL student achievement.
